The course aims to increase learners' confidence in facilitating effective and holistic support to those in need of advice and assistance. Through discussion, the course will demystify what can be considered a complex process and identify ways to manage all issues surrounding homelessness.

Face to Face tutor facilitation, questionnaires, fact sheets and scenarios for breakout groups, questioning and participation and an end of session assessment.
