Target Audience

Managers, Deputies and Team Leaders across a range of Housing, Health and Social Care settings who have a responsibility for dignity, respect and values within practice with the services they manage and lead.

In the workplace there are principles linked to behaviours so that people deliver exceptional care and support. This course has been developed to support learners to build the skills, knowledge, attitudes and values with the teams they are leading and managing. We will look at embedding these practices for both the people they are supporting and across the staff teams.
